- There is currently 1928 Reds Saver account holders with balances of £6.9 million in total.
- The club receives an annual bonus of 1% of the average daily balance of the accounts as a whole direct from the Society.
- This payment is traditionally made at the start of the new season.
- Last season's payment made by the Society on behalf of Reds Saver account holders was for £68,015.68.
